

CONFIDENTIALITY AND PRIVACY POLICY

Version: May 2024

1. Preamble

1.1. One of the main priorities of JustforexGO (hereinafter referred to as the “Company” and/or “we” and/or “our” and/or “us”) is the full security of Clients information. The Company does not allow this information to become open to the general public and to be used by a third party. The Company does not provide, sell, disclose, or give for temporary use Client's information and account details to third parties. The company values its reputation and respects the Company's Clients.

1.2 The company values its reputation and respect the Company's Clients.

2. Gathering of the Information

2.1. The Company gathers every information from every Client. It includes: full name, date of birth, country of residence, complete address, including phone number and city code etc. All this information is given by the Client during registration of the Personal Area. Gathering information is an obligatory condition for the beginning of business relationship with the Company.

3. Personal Data that is Collected by the Company

3.1. Personal data, provided by Clients includes:

- information provided by the Client during the Personal Arearegistration (full name, date of birth, country of residence, complete address, phone number and city code);
- documents that allows the Company verify the Client’s Personal Area, namely government-issued identification documents (passport, national ID, driver's licence, or similar document) and documents that confirm the place of residence (utility bill (gas, water, electricity or other), bank statement or similar document) as mentioned in the AML Policy;
- documents that confirm money transfer (in case of bank transfer, based on the Company's decision);
- and any other information customarily used to identify the Client, if requested by the Company.

4. Cookies

4.1. The Company uses Cookies to provide effective work of the site and to create statistics report.

4.2. The usage of these files will let the Company organize site in a comfortable way and make the pages of the website useful for the clients. Cookies are small files, that contain data on Client activity on Company's website. They are installed on the Client's computer when the Client visits Company's website and when the Client visits it for the next time, they let extract this information. Cookies contain a string of characters and it is the identifier of Client's browser. These files are used for tracking visitors of the website and providing faster and more convenient access. This

information does not identify Clients, it just lets the Company estimate Client's interest in the services of the Company and activity on the site. All the information is anonymous. The Client can stop receiving Cookies by choosing appropriate command in the menu of the browser.

5. The Use of Information

5.1. Information given by the Client is used solely to provide quality services. For example, Client's contact information may be used in case the Company needs to contact the Client urgently or to inform the Client about the Company's updates and news. By providing information about himself, the Client verifies personal Personal Area thus participating in bringing the AML policy to life.

Client's data is used to confirm the Client's identity, to open trading and/or partner accounts, to quickly inform about new services of the Company, to maintain the database of customers' accounts, and to analyze statistical data for providing services and products of higher quality.

6. Disclosure of Information to Third Parties

6.1. The Company keeps the right to give information about the Client to third parties only under special circumstances. Such circumstances may be:

- protection of personal rights and property in the court;
- implementing of court orders;
- providing information to law enforcement authorities at official request;
- transferring of information to business partners (trustees) to improve the quality of service.

In order to give the Clients comprehensive, state-of-the-art high-quality service, the Company may exchange personal data with its business partners. At the request of the Client, the Company can provide information about the services that the partners provide for it.

7. Changes in Personal Data

7.1. Because the Company assumes that all the information is full and relevant, the Company asks the Client to notify the Company of any changes in the personal data via the appropriate forms of the Personal Area.

8. Refusal to Provide Personal Information

8.1. The Client has the right to refuse to provide personal information required by the regulations, if it goes against Client's beliefs. However, in this case, the Company would not be able to provide the Client its services.
